



Over the past 60 years, the Rotary Club of Dunedin has been dedicated to serving the Dunedin community through a variety of projects.

In celebration of the Rotary Club of Dunedin's 60th anniversary, our goal is to raise \$50,000 for scholarships to high school students who live in Dunedin.

This \$50,000 will go to the Rotary Club of Dunedin Foundation, which is a 501 3-C tax exempt foundation. Each year the Club Foundation distributes five percent of the total assets in part for Dunedin scholarships. The Foundation currently has assets of about \$500,000 and has already awarded more than \$96,000 in scholarships to high school students living in Dunedin.

Since the Foundation distributes a percentage of its total assets to scholarships, your contribution will never be used up. By donating to the Rotary Club of Dunedin Foundation, you will be investing your money in an endowment that will continue to benefit students for years to come.
