

There are two County Connection Centers established six years ago, one in North and South County, to help bring county government to the people. Information on programs and services is available. The Centers also provide a vehicle for residents to voice concerns or provide a representative to meet with residents on problems.

The Center's website provides opportunities to sign up for e-mails on specific subjects of interest. It also provides streaming video on County meetings, including specific County Commission agenda item. It provides a wealth of storm preparedness info too.
