

Last Week's Program – National Armed Services and Law Enforcement Memorial Museum

Stephanie Fenton, program chair, introduced Bob Ayers, a Dunedin native and our first motorcycle cop, who gave interesting details about Dunedin's history during WW II and promoted the museum as a source of information about military and police history. Some bits of history: Dunedin has 2 Blue Star

Memorial Markers; Dunedin is the first Purple Heart City; in WWII there was a Marine base on Bayshore and Grant Field was used for practice digging foxholes; those serving stayed at the Fenway and Ft. Harrison Hotels; alligator landing crafts were built at a plant on Douglas Ave; in 1945 the airport on Bayshore burned down and Bob Ayers took licks for skipping school and to watch; dive bombers from MacDill dropped bombs on the site of Countryside Mall; Dunedin has 3 survivors from the Bataan Death March. To learn more about Dunedin's history come to the museum and buy a book and listen to Bob Ayers give talks on the military and police artifacts. The NASLEEM Museum, opened in 1998, is located at 500 Douglas Ave. in Dunedin.
